0730 CDT

- Planning, assignments, and logistics overview.

0815 CDT

- Contact attempted with Pass Christian
- John Campton, City Building Official, has arranged a meeting with Acting Chief Operating Officer for Pass Christian.

1000 CDT

- Harrison County EOC has faxed Mission 5 to State EOC for EMAC Number.

1030 CDT

- Spoke with Deputy Chief Bass regarding FEMA requirements for documentation of time and duties and the need to keep records daily. A standing offer of assistance was extended to assist in collection and review of documents. Deputy Chief Bass states that Long Beach Finance has the matter under control and is completing the necessary forms city-wide.

1215 CDT

- Met with Pass Christian Chief Operation Officer Malcolm Jones and John Campton. Campton has been designated as the contact person for Pass Christian. City was hit hard by Katrina and structures still standing need to be inspected. Needs for Pass Christian are as follows:
  - 5 Building Inspectors to conduct structural assessments
  - 2 Engineers to conduct infrastructure assessments similar to ones done in Long Beach
  - 1 IT person
  - 1 GIS person

1530 CDT

- Conversations with Mississippi EOC, Florida EMAC Chief Chuck Hagan, Ashley Skellie in an attempt to get EMAC Number for Mission 5. According to Chuck Hagan, Req. A has been signed and sent to

Mississippi EOC for approval and Mississippi EOC is holding Mission 5 Req. A until costs and Req. A received from Missions 1 through 4. Missions 1 through 4 data will not be ready until late Wednesday. Long Beach is attempting to get Mississippi EOC to approve Mission 5 as submitted and wait for data on other missions.

1640 CDT

- Mission 5 has been approved at this time per both Florida and Mississippi. Missions 1 through 4 will be reviewed once submitted.
