GOALS:

SUMMARY:

- Met with George and David Bass. George Bass is interested in participating in the Charleston Management Practices Conference in South Carolina. Long Beach does not need the pumper truck, however they will see if any neighboring communities are interested.
- I have tried several times to reach Ashley Skellie with no luck regarding coordinating humanitarian assistance to employees.
- Met with Mayor Skellie to try and get a scope of work for what the carpenter would be doing for Mission 10 to identify needed tools, work schedule and such.
- Met with FEMA rep today to discuss a mitigation project to purchase ESRI Arc products. Long Beach is currently using temporary licenses that will expire in March. We requested an additional six month extension, but want to get the

paperwork started to get FEMA to purchase the software. Lauren (FEMA rep) seemed to think that would be reasonable and requested that we write up the project scope.

- Chief Bass requested a replica of Right of entry database, Dave put a stand alone version on his laptop and created a data entry form to update specific information as he inspects and releases properties for demolition.
- Met with Alderman Richard Bennett he is going to arrange for us to meet with Gulf Regional Planning Commission to also try to get assistance to continue the GIS effort here in Long Beach. He is going to try and arrange something for Thursday.
