DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Discussion regarding the priorities for the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board

Mayor Burnette opened the meeting for all to discuss their goals for the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board.

Council asked for the Board to prioritize the needs of the City and keep in mind the costs involved. Discussion was held regarding what would be included in a community center. The Board's priority list includes 1) Community Center, 2) Land acquisition for future sports complex, 3) Co-sponsored events, 4) trails system, and 5) The Foundation. Funding with Volusia Forever and ECHO was discussed. Mr. Wiles asked Council to consider applying for an ECHO grant to expand the gym.

Council consensus was to move forward with expanding the gym at City Center with ECHO funds by 2020. Phase 2 can include a community center near Creekside Middle School to include funding options to be discussed for completion by 2022. The City Manager will continue working on expansion at Coraci Park.

Next joint workshop date: May 2018 to include Gamble Place and a sports complex.

Robert Reinhagen, citizen, would like to see profits come from Palmer College and the YMCA which could be used to fund the items discussed above.
