4. Monthly Financial Report

Tracey Riehm, Finance Director, provided details from the Financial Report for February 2018.

5. Half Cent Sales Tax Project Priority List

Jake Johansson, City Manager, provided details relating to the background of infrastructure needs, current revenue issues, and inadequate resources to address increasing water and flooding issues. He also addressed possible projects already needed. A local citizen advisory committee will be formed to oversee the expenditures of each project and ensure the funds are being spent as approved in the referendum, should it be approved by voters. The funds would be restricted to infrastructure projects only.

Councilman Ford would like to include Dunlawton Avenue to the list of road projects. Mr. Johansson said the TPO project list will also be included which include several Dunlawton Avenue projects. He suggested working to prioritize them in three-year increments if it gets approved.

Vice Mayor Stiltner asked for this information to be added to the City's website once the ballot language is approved.
