DISCUSSION ITEMS

4. Recycling Presentation by GEL Corporation

Lynn Stevens, Public Works/Utilities Director, discussed the City's current recycling services.

Jacqueline Kerr – Financial Controller GEL CORP, provided education regarding recycled materials and how it is processed once received. The City of Port Orange has recycled 669 tons of mixed paper from January-August 2018. The City's recycling program has saved 11,373 trees, 4.68 million gallons of water, and 309,747 gallons of oil.

Ms. Stevens advised Council there will need to be changes to the contract because of the commodity drop. The rates to the residents will not be changed. The City has lost the rebate from the County.

5. Dunlawton Medians

Margaret Tomlinson, Construction and Engineering Manager, provided details regarding the project for medians on Dunlawton Ave. Some of the lessons learned include relocating Crape Myrtles, new irrigations system, and a 1-year maintenance agreement. She discussed the cost and schedule implications and asked Council for direction.
