

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF PORT
ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR
THE CLOSURE OF CITY OF PORT ORANGE OFFICES;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 22-219 on September 24, 2022, declaring that a state of emergency exists in every county in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Port Orange has declared a Local State of Emergency beginning September 26, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. pursuant to Resolution 22-31; and

WHEREAS, the Hurricane Ian Storm Event may cause damage to public utilities, public buildings, public streets and roads, public drainage systems, potentially other public infrastructure, commercial and residential buildings and areas as well as causing life threatening conditions for the residents; and

WHEREAS, all City of Port Orange offices will close at noon on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 and remain closed Thursday, September 29, 2022. City of Port Orange offices will remain closed on Friday, September 30, 2022, unless the City Manager determines that it is safe to resume normal business operations.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered by the Emergency Management Director of the City of Port Orange, Volusia County, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. All City of Port Orange offices will close at noon on Wednesday, September 28, 2022, and remain closed Thursday, September 29, 2022. City of Port Orange offices will also remain closed on Friday, September 30, 2022, unless the City Manager determines it is safe to resume normal business operations.

SECTION 2. This Executive Order shall become effective immediately.
