

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3 (NICOLE)

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSURE OF CITY OF PORT ORANGE OFFICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2022, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 22-253, declaring that a state of emergency exists in Volusia County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Port Orange has declared a Local State of Emergency beginning November 8, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. pursuant to Resolution 22-42; and

WHEREAS, the Subtropical Storm Nicole Storm Event may cause damage to public utilities, public buildings, public streets and roads, public drainage systems, potentially other public infrastructure, commercial and residential buildings and areas as well as causing life threatening conditions for the residents; and


WHEREAS, City offices will be closed at noon on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 and remain closed Thursday, November 10, 2022 due to the Subtropical Storm Nicole Storm Event.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered by the Emergency Management Director of the City of Port Orange, Volusia County, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. All City of Port Orange offices will close at noon on Wednesday, November 9, 2022, and remain closed Thursday, November 10, 2022. As the City is closed Friday, November 11, 2022, in observance of Veterans Day, the City will resume normal business operations on Monday, November 14, 2022.

SECTION 2. This Executive Order shall become effective immediately and shall expire upon reopening of City offices and commencement of normal business activity.
