CITY OF PORT ORANGE ANNOUNCES AQUAHAWK

Free online alerting system for water customers to efficiently manage water usage

Port Orange, FL...The City of Port Orange is happy to announce AquaHawk, a free, easy-to-use online tool to assist its water customers to better understand and efficiently manage their usage of drinking, reuse and irrigation water.

AquaHawk can help customers with water consumption by providing them with easy-to-understand graphs showing how and when water is used in their homes. It can even indicate when there is a leak inside or outside the home. This service can also assist in creating a monthly water budget by sending alerts when a cost or use limit is reached for a household. Users set their own unique thresholds and choose an amount of water (gallons) or an estimated bill amount (dollars) they do not want to exceed.

“Leaks are often undetectable,” said Lynn Stevens, Public Utilities Director. “You may not be aware you have a problem until the bill comes. This service allows people to be notified of issues within hours by requesting AquaHawk to notify you by phone, text or email when an alert level is exceeded. It will provide customers the ability to control and better understand how they use their water.”
