

## Yard Signs Requirements in Port Orange



The dimensional requirements and maximum number of yard signs allowed on a lot are listed below [Chapter 15 of the Land Development Code].

Additional three (3) Yard Signs are allowed per Lot during the following time periods in 2023	45 days prior to an election day: July 8 Additional three (3) signs on a lot shall be removed by August 27  45 days prior to an election day: September 23 Additional three (3) signs on a lot shall be removed by November 12		

## Yard Sign Location and Material Requirements

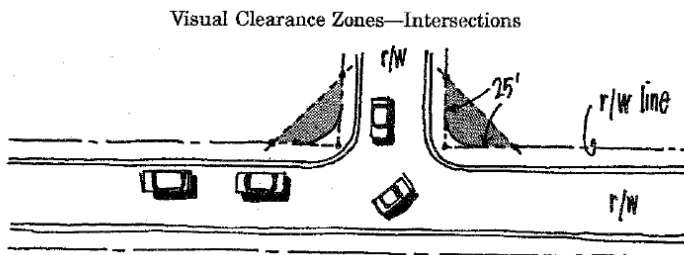
Yard Signs may only be placed on a lot with the property owner's permission.

Yard Signs shall not be placed within the public road right of way [Chapter 15 of the Land Development Code].

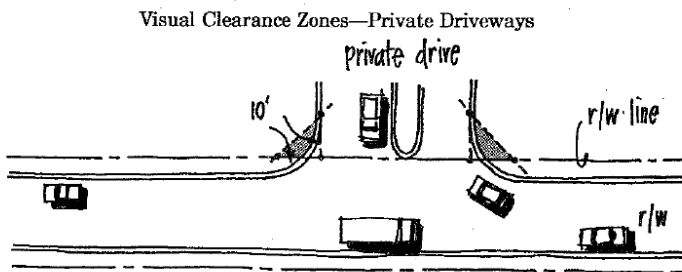
Yard Signs shall not be attached to trees, street signs, fence, or power poles [Chapter 15 of the Land Development Code].

Yard Signs shall not impede the view at intersections and are not allowed to be placed within the visual clearance zones located on private property [Chapter 16 of the Land Development Code]:

- 25 feet from the intersection of two public roads



- 10 feet from the intersection of a public road and a private driveway



Yard signs shall be constructed of durable, all-weather materials and may include but are not limited to metal, plexiglass, fiberglass, wood, plastic substrate, plywood, woven fabrics, vinyl fabrics, or other approved materials.
