Residential Swimming Pool Safety Requirements Chapter 45, 2017 Florida Building Code, Residential (6th Edition)

My contractor has informed me that prior to the use of my pool, I will need a safety barrier installed in accordance with the Florida Building Code and that all inspection approvals including final inspection, will have been obtained. The 2017 Florida Building Code 6th Edition requires pools to be enclosed by a barrier meeting the requirements of R4501.17

INDICATE YOUR METHOD OF COMPLIANCE BY CHECKING THE APPROPRIATE BOX(ES).

- The pool will be equipped with an approved safety pool cover complying with ASTM F 1346-91 or pool guard NSF Certified to ASTM F2208
- The pool will be isolated from access from the home and yard by an enclosure meeting the barrier requirements of Section R4501.17, 2017 Florida Building Code Residential (6th Edition)
- All doors and windows providing direct access from the home to the pool will be equipped with an exit alarm complying with UL 2017 that has a minimum sound pressure rating of 85 dB A at 10 feet and is either hard-wired or the plug-in-type. The exit alarm shall produce a continuous audible warning, be capable of being heard throughout the house during normal household duties, and be equipped with a properly located manual means to temporarily deactivate the alarm for not more than 15 seconds for a single opening.
- All doors providing direct access from the home to the pool (not equipped with exit alarms) will be equipped with a self-closing, self-latching device with positive mechanical latching/locking installed a minimum of 54 inches above the threshold.

According to Section 515.27 F.S., a person who fails to equip a new residential swimming pool with at least one pool safety feature as required above commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or 775.083.

I also understand that steel & ground, underground (open ditch), and deck inspection are required in addition to the final inspection. Access to the interior of the home is required if alarms or self-closing/self-latching doors are used to meet the above requirements.
