The Port Orange Police Department Citizen Police Academy is a training program for the citizens of Port Orange. The Citizen Police Academy is offered to residents to provide familiarization with the operation of the Port Orange Police Department. The Citizen Police Academy will meet on Monday evenings from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m. for 10 weeks, starting on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Representatives from the police department will instruct a different subject each week. Participants will have the opportunity to view demonstrations of police practices and equipment. Participants will **NOT** be trained as police officers! The class is **FREE** but limited to the first **30** eligible participants.

### Enrollment criteria:

1. Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
2. Applicants must be residents of the City of Port Orange.
3. Applicants must not have any felony arrests.
4. Applicants must not have any arrest for domestic battery.
5. Applicants must not have any arrest within the preceding 6 months (or longer if the matter is still pending).

**Selection process:** It is the intention of the Port Orange Police Department to present Citizen Police Academy classes annually. Class size is limited. When enrollment exceeds capacity, the command staff of the police department may be called upon to select from the list of qualified applicants a group that represents a diverse cross section of residents. Applicants that have not previously attended the CPA will have preference over anyone that has attended in the past.

**Dress Code:** Business casual attire for the classroom portions of the course is required.
