**Mr. Flagg is a retired local general contractor from 1976 – 2011 who built numerous commercial buildings throughout Volusia County including the South Daytona City Hall, Daytona Beach Airport Traffic Control Facility, various FPL substations, and numerous churches including the Port Orange Lutheran Church.**

**In November 2011, Mr. Frank Flagg came to work with the City of Port Orange to oversee major facility construction projects. His accomplishments since beginning his second career with Port Orange include City Hall roof replacement and rooftop air conditioning replacement; demolition and rebuilding the old city police department into the new Dorothy L Hukill City Annex; re-roof, hardening and interior rehabilitation of Fire Station 73 (3 different projects); 4 renovations at the YMCA Pool; City Police Department Evidence Room Rehabilitation; Public Works Exterior Remodeling and Re-roofing; Rehabilitation of a residence after major flooding; and assessing and estimating repairs on all city structures after hurricanes Matthew and Irma. He has worked with every department in the City assisting with the development of work scopes on numerous construction projects, developing accurate budgetary cost estimates, and assists departments issues on various construction projects beyond his job duties. He is very detail oriented and his work performance goes way beyond the call of duty for his position.**
