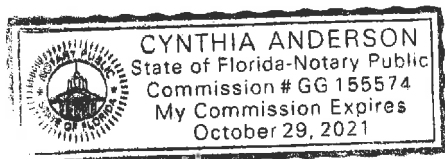

Center Circle, Port Orange, FL. This

City's adopted Citizen Participation Plan  
(Resolution No. 06-49), as required by  
24 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) 91.  
The City of Port Orange's Community  
Development Block Grant (CDBG)  
program is funded through the U.S.

Aligned with the adopted Five (5) Year
