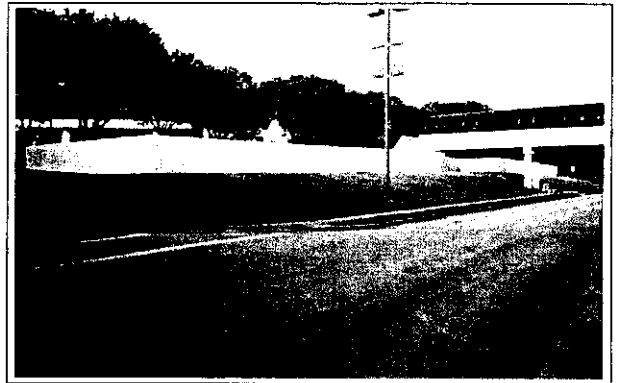

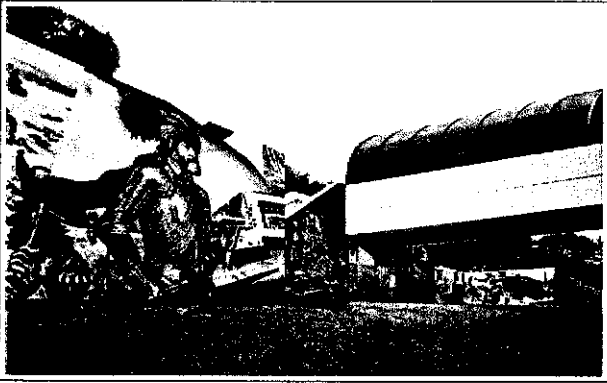

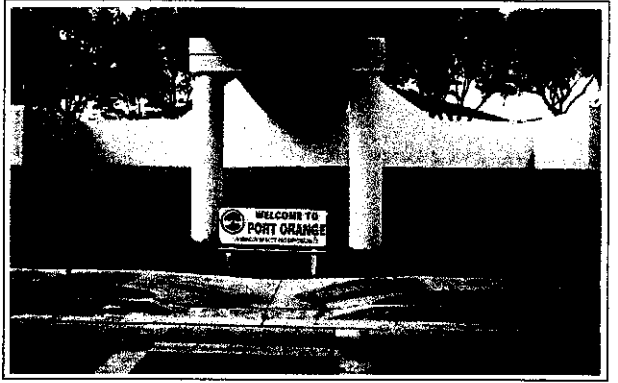
Present time (detail)



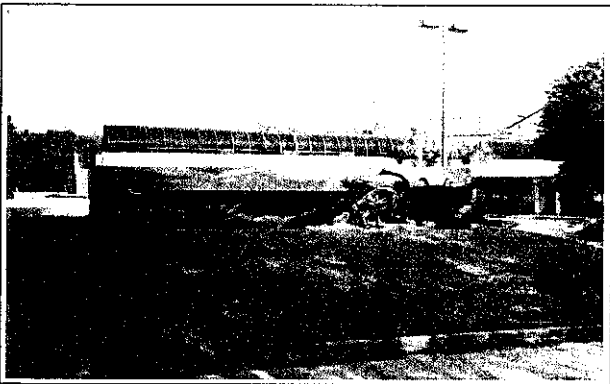

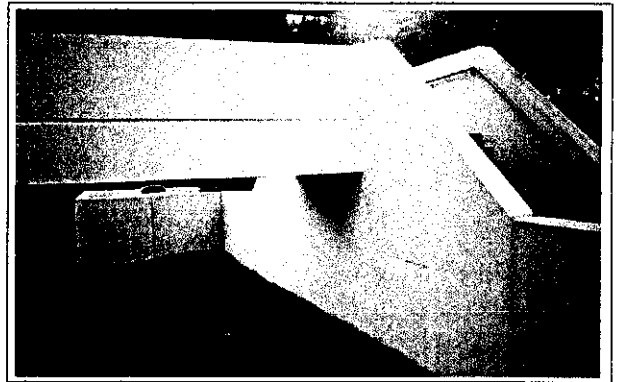
Colonial period (Detail)
