

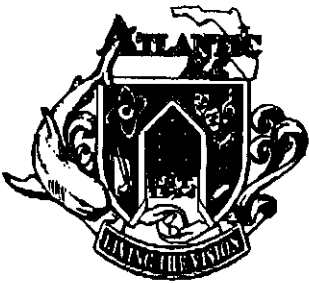
We are asking Council to extend this agreement for the 2008-2009 calendar year.
