## SUMMER SAFETY BILLBOARD CONTEST

### Guidelines

- ❖ **Eligibility:** All students in grades K-5 enrolled at any Port Orange public school are eligible. The winning entry will be transformed into a billboard and displayed during the summer months.
- ❖ **Themes:** Posters must reflect one of the following themes:
  - a. smoke detectors save lives
  - b. wear your helmet (and other bike safety messages)
  - c. be "water smart" (lifejackets, storm danger, etc.)
  - d. practice exit drills in the home
  - e. stay away from matches and lights (including fireworks)
  - f. practice fire safety when cooking
- ❖ **Poster size:** Suggested size is 14" x 22" on poster board. (Posters must be drawn horizontally, look at a billboard for similar horizontal shape.)
- ❖ **Artwork:** All ideas must be original, no Internet images, magazine clippings, stencils, etc. Only crayons, ink, felt-tip pens and/or paint may be used.
- ❖ **Identification:** Each poster needs to have student's name, address, age, school, teacher and grade printed on the back (w/ Parent Signed Permission needed).
- ❖ **Judging:** A panel comprised of firefighters will judge the entries on the following criteria: communication of theme, originality, neatness, clearness of thought, and conformity to contest rules.
- ❖ **Deadline:** All entries must be submitted to your school's main office (City Center) by: May 22<sup>nd</sup> at the end of the school day. (All entries become the property of Port Orange Fire & Rescue.)
- ❖ **Awards**
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$100 savings bond, Certificate signed by the Fire Chief, and their artwork displayed as a BILLBOARD in the Port Orange area.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$50 savings bond and a 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Certificate of merit signed by the Fire Chief.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$50 savings bond and a 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Certificate of merit signed by the Fire Chief.The top three posters from each school will be displayed in the Port Orange Public Library for one month.

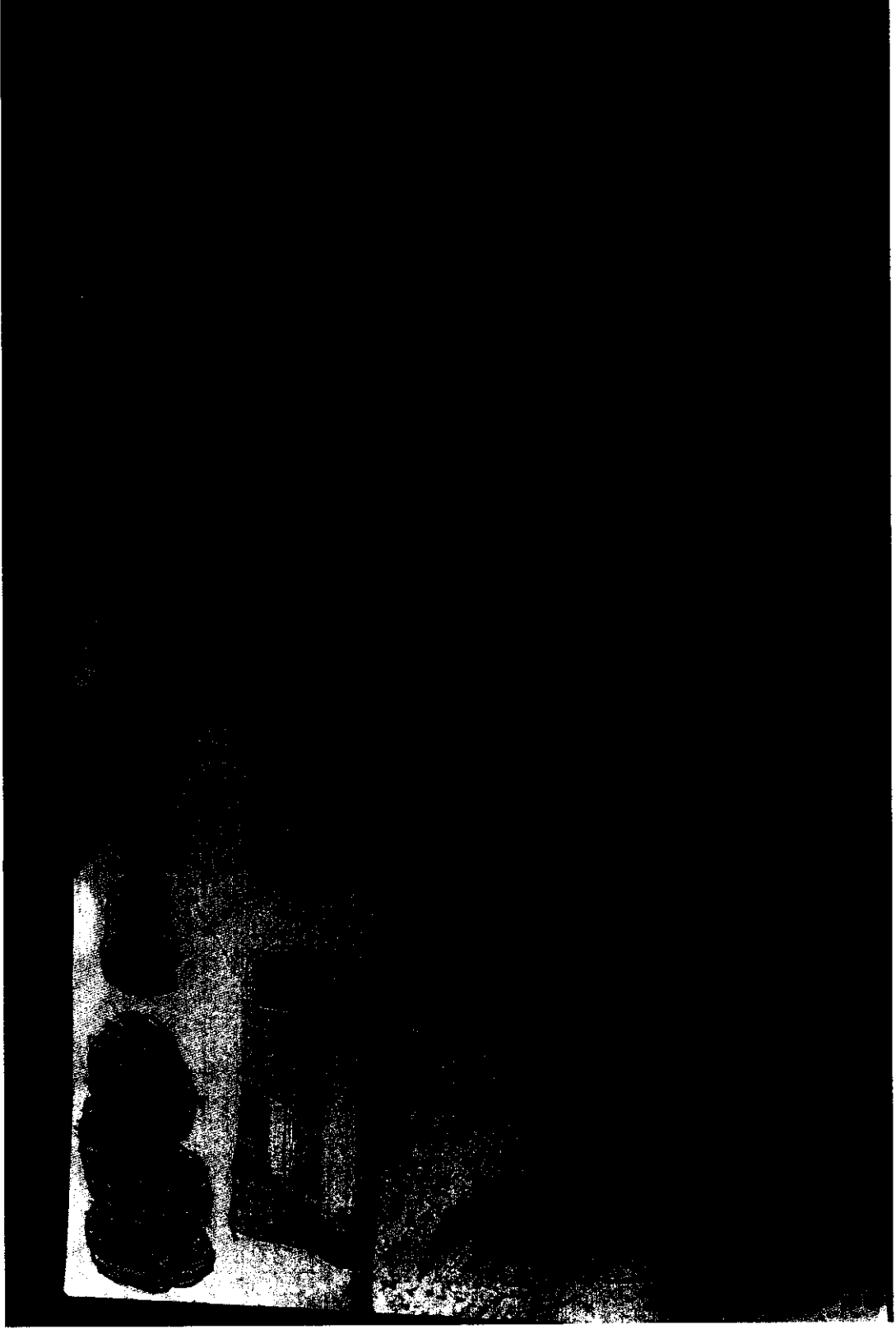
