SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO SUBMIT PROJECTS FOR THE MPO's 2009 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PRIORITY LIST

DEPARTMENT: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

To approve and authorize the City staff to submit applications for the 2009 Priority Project requests for transportation improvements to the Volusia Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO).

SUMMARY:

Staff requests that the City Council approve and authorize submittal of applications for projects to be placed on the MPO project priority list. The projects identified in attachment 'A' consists of road intersection (traffic operation) improvements and bicycle/pedestrian facility improvements. The projects require a 25 percent local government match to assist in funding the improvements. The local match required for all projects on the list totals \$268,101 for the estimated \$1,072,402 in improvements. Please see the attached memo for additional information.

Introduction

This item consists of a proposed list of projects identified by Community Development staff that the City should consider submitting to the Volusia Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for inclusion in its Priority List for 2009. These projects will require a local match by the city as described below.

Background

Each year, the MPO requests a list of projects from area local governments for possible inclusion in the update of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Priority Project list. Priority projects are those from the TIP that can be accelerated to receive funding within 2-3 years.

This year, the MPO has limited its request for projects to only four categories described below. This does not include capacity projects, such as roadway widenings. The four project categories eligible for submittal include:

- XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Projects, (intersection improvement or signalization)
- XU Bicycle/Pedestrian Set-aside Projects, (sidewalk extension or filling gaps)
- Enhancement (Bicycle/Pedestrian) Projects, and (longer-term bike/ped and extension projects)
- Enhancement (Other Projects) (non transportation projects such as landscaping or transportation facility restoration).

Proposed Projects for 2009

The list proposed by Community Development staff was developed with input from Public Works, Public Utilities, and the CRA staff. The projects proposed for this year are listed in the attached table (Attachment 'A') and indicated in the attached location map. The list includes three traffic operations/safety projects (intersection improvements) and six sidewalk projects. The intersection improvements are intended to improve traffic flow and safety. The sidewalk/bikepath projects are those which will create the greatest immediate

benefit by filling in gaps in existing sidewalks and bikepaths. Doing so will make entire sections of the network safer and more usable.

Should the Council elect to submit these requests or a modification of this list, staff will prepare applications and submit them to meet the **April 3, 2009 deadline**. The MPO will then review and evaluate the projects through their committees (BPAC, TCC and CAC), and the MPO Board will select and rank projects for inclusion in the TIP. The MPO will take action to adopt the Priority Project List on May 26, 2009.

Please note that the City already has several projects included in the MPO's TIP from previous years, such as the intersection improvement at US 1 and Dunlawton Avenue and the FPL Corridor trail. The ones being proposed now are this year's addition to the list. The Priority List application packet and list of projects now in the TIP are provided in Attachment 'B'.

Funding

The projects being proposed for this year require a 25% local match. The three traffic operations/safety projects have a total cost estimate of \$650,500, which will require a city match of \$162,625. The six Bike/Ped projects total an estimated \$421,902, which will require a city match of \$105,476. The total local match required comes to \$268,101. The City can score an additional 10 out of 100 points by providing greater than a 25% match for the XU Bike/Ped projects (i.e. 25.1%).

Staff has confirmed that none of the projects being proposed are eligible for funding using TIF revenues through the City's two CRAs. It should also be noted that the list does not include any projects eligible for CDBG money. Because the City's CDBG money accumulated over the past three years must be spent by July of this year, it will not be available 2-3 years from now when the Priority Project money becomes available. Staff is now developing a separate list of design-build sidewalk/ bikepath projects to be funded by this July through CDBG. In future years, the City will be able to use CDBG money as the 25% local match for future Priority Projects funded through the MPO, within CDBG-eligible areas of the City.

Recommendation

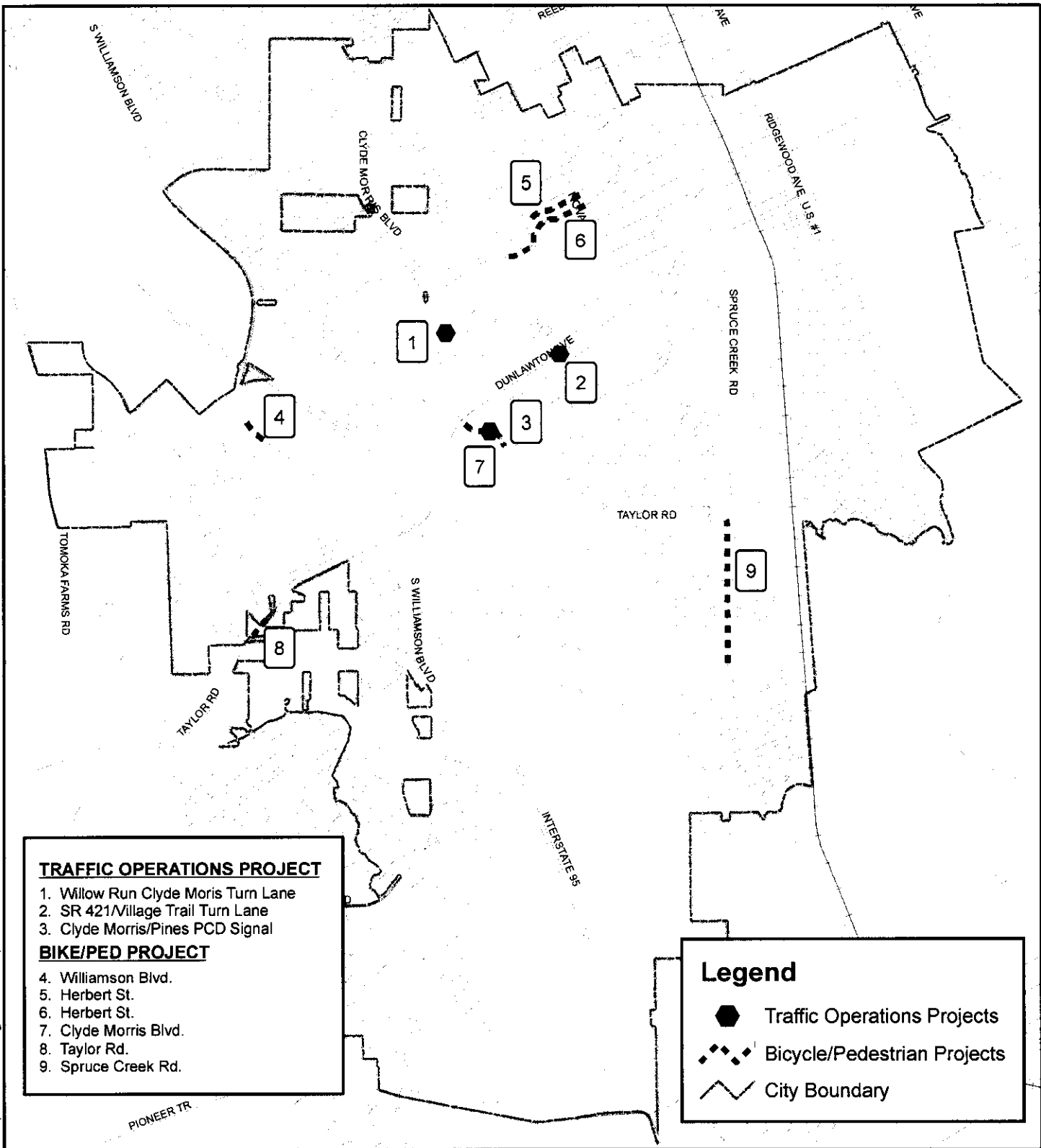
Staff recommends **approval** to the 2009 Priority Project list and to authorize submittal of applications to the Volusia Metropolitan Planning Organization.

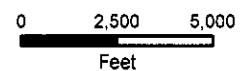

FOR YOUR IMMEDIATE ATTENTION: TIME SENSITIVE MATERIALS ENCLOSED

The Volusia County MPO is now accepting transportation project applications for the Priority Project Process. These applications will be ranked by the MPO and will be used by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to compete for federal and state transportation funding.

The MPO has seven categories of Priority Project Lists, which are:

- Florida Intrastate Highway System (FIHS) and/or the Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) Roadway Projects,
Regionally Significant Non-FIHS/SIS Roadway Projects,
Bascule Bridge Projects,
XU Public Transportation Set-aside Projects,
XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Set-aside Projects,
XU Bicycle/Pedestrian Set-aside Projects, and
Enhancement Bicycle/Pedestrian and "Other" Enhancement Projects.

The Volusia County MPO is now accepting transportation project applications for the following Priority Project Lists:

- XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Projects,
XU Bicycle/Pedestrian Set-aside Projects,
Enhancement (Bicycle/Pedestrian) Projects, and
Enhancement (Other) Projects.

The XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety and XU Bicycle/Pedestrian project application process is similar to a "Grant Based" application process, where a local government will have to match the funds from the MPO to complete the project. The XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety projects require a 25% local match, and the XU Bicycle/Pedestrian projects require a 25% local match.

Enhancement projects do not require a local match. Please refer to the following FHWA website for details on eligible projects for transportation enhancement funds: http://www.fhwa.dot.gov/environment/te/teas.htm

Applicants wishing to submit for the above listed project types must submit the following applications:

- ◆ Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety projects must fill-out the MPO's XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Priority Project Application,
- ◆ XU Bicycle or Pedestrian projects must fill-out the MPO's XU (Bicycle/Pedestrian) Priority Project Application.
- ◆ Enhancement Bicycle or Pedestrian projects must fill-out two applications: (1) the MPO's Enhancement (Bicycle/Pedestrian) Priority Project Application, and (2) the FDOT's Enhancement Project Application,
- ◆ Enhancement (Other), for non-bicycle or pedestrian projects, must fill-out FDOT's Enhancement Project Application.

Project sponsors of Enhancement "Other" projects will be given the opportunity to orally present their projects for ranking to the TCC and CAC members. They will use the information included in the FDOT Enhancement application form, as well as the oral presentation, to rank these projects.

- ◆ Schedule for the 2008 TIP Priority Project Process,
- ◆ Last year's list of XU Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Priority Projects,

- ◆ Enhancement (Bicycle/Pedestrian) Priority Project Application, and
- ◆ FDOT's Enhancement Project Application.
